

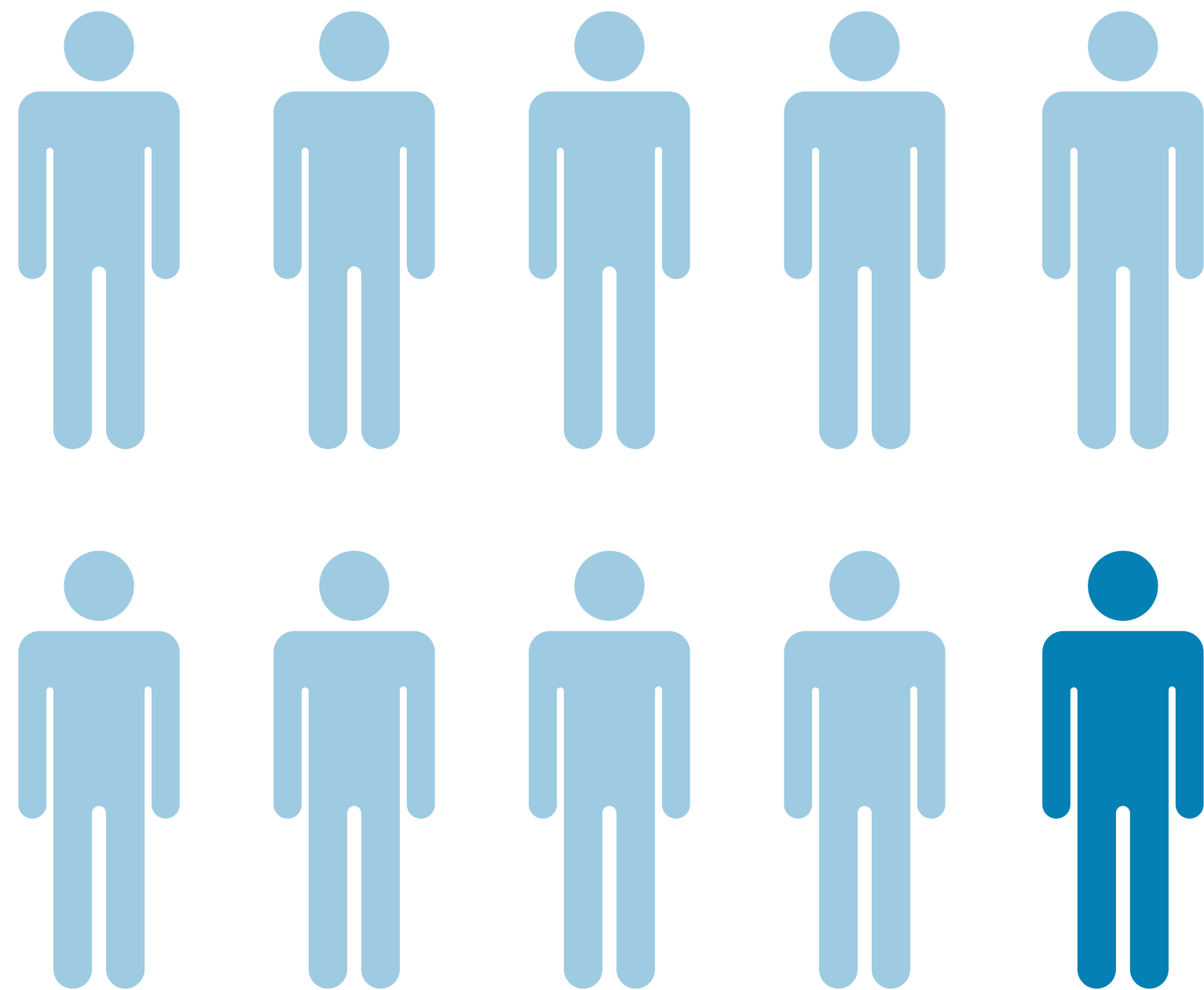

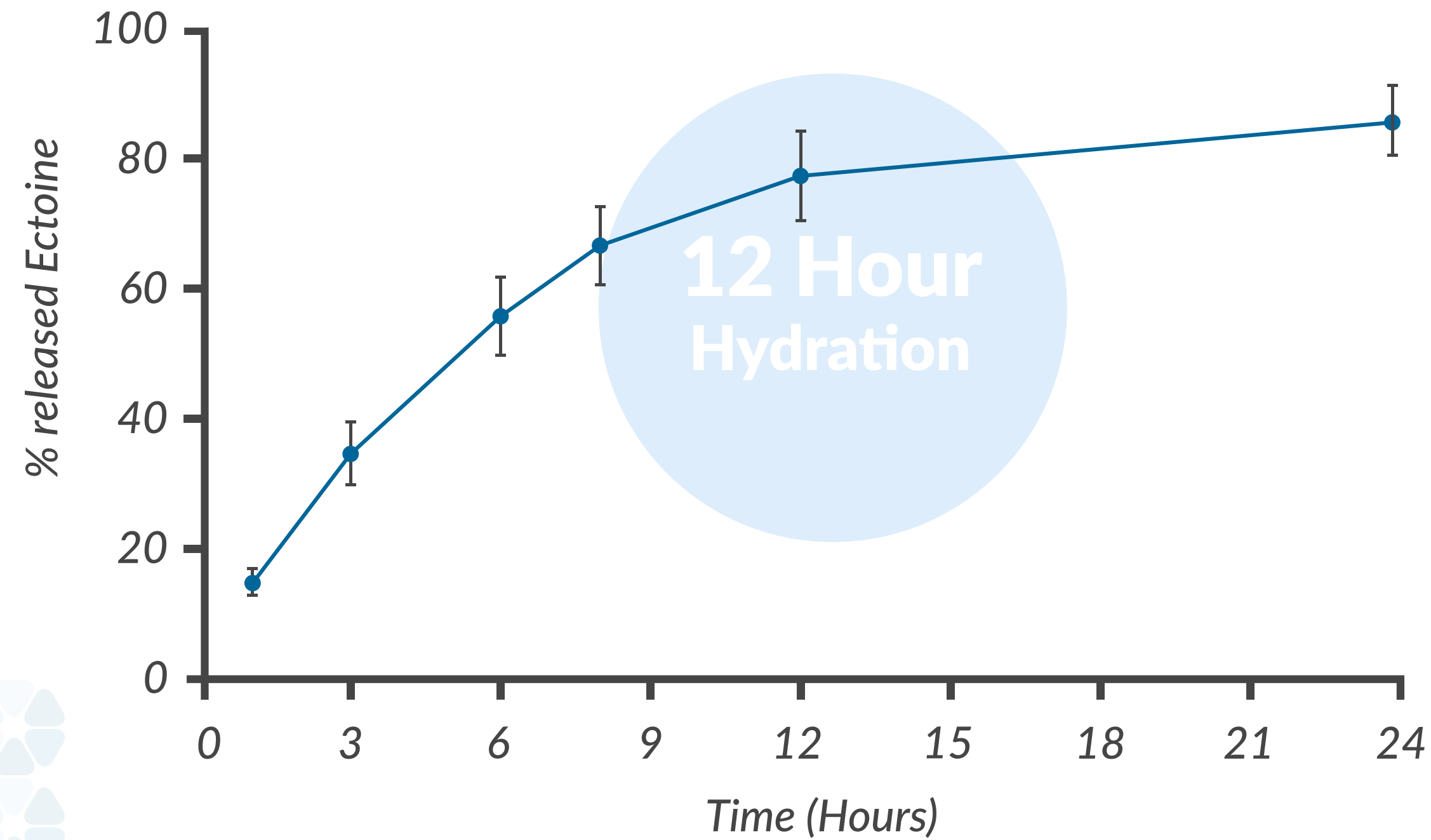

DayDrop is a sterile, pH buffered, preservative and phosphate free eye solution.

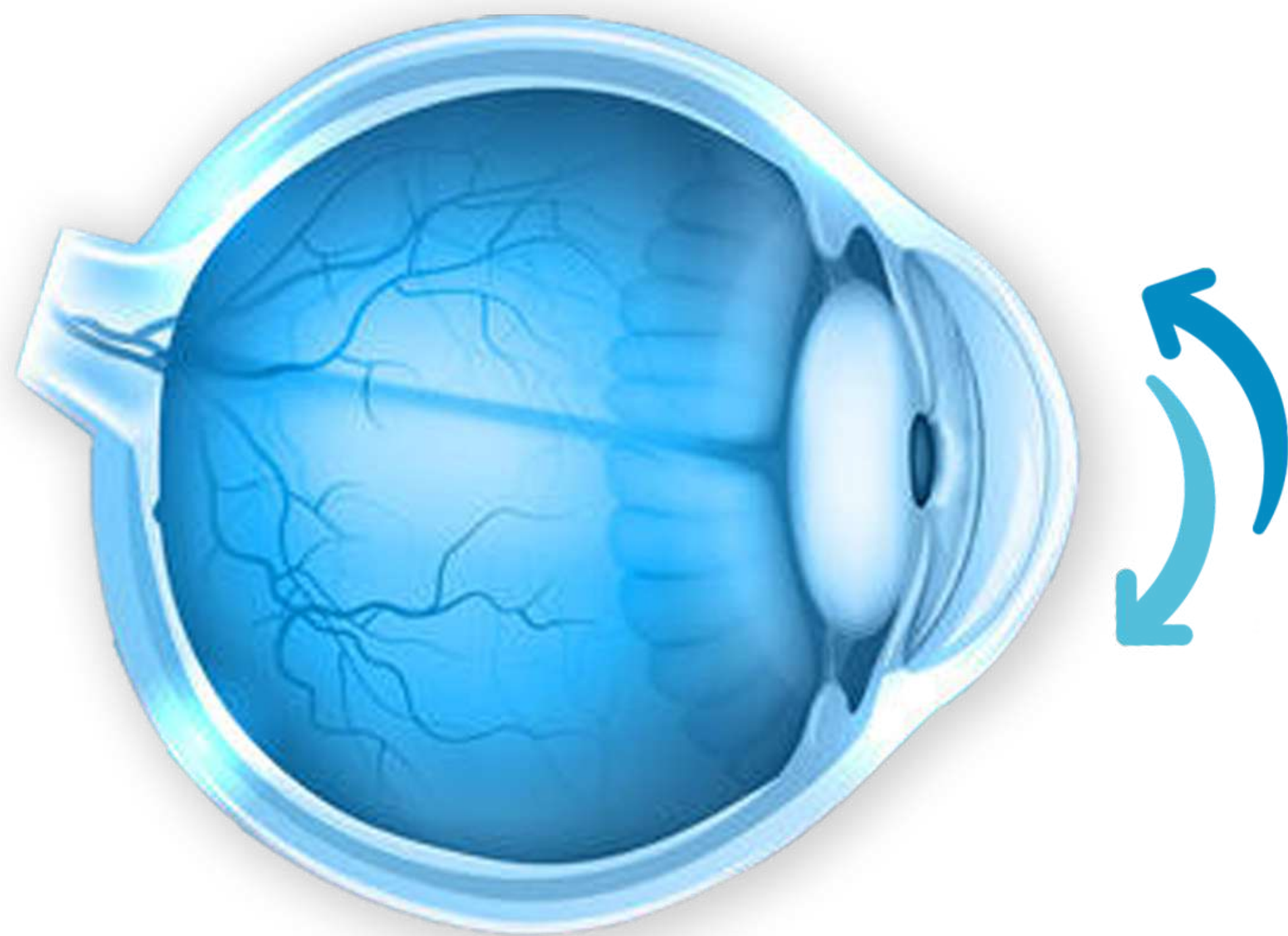


Curve showing the release of ectoine in **DayDrop** within 12 Hours.

How DayDrop acts
